Badminton Group In-House Tournaments

It has long been a tradition for our badminton group to hold two in-house tournaments each year, organized entirely by volunteers.

Participation is open to all members, regardless of skill level. A modest entry fee helps cover expenses, while lunch--open to the entire membership—serves as both a social gathering and the highlight of the day. It is during lunch that tournament winners receive their medals and trophies, followed by lively raffle draws for lucky participants.

The June Tournament follows a round-robin format. Players are grouped in sets of eight based on skill level. Prizes are awarded to the champion, runner-up, and second runner-up of each group.

The November Tournament offers a different experience. Four captains are appointed and select their team members through a fair, balanced system. The winning team earns the honour of having their names engraved on a perpetual trophy proudly displayed at the Bonsor 55+ Senior Centre. This tournament also concludes with a social celebration, recognizing both the victorious team and the group's spirit of camaraderie.
